RECRUITMENT OF HEALTH WORKERS FOR THE UNIVERSAL HEALTH PROGRAMME PROGRAMME

The County Government of Nyeri wishes to recruit competent and qualified persons to work on a locum basis under the Universal Health Coverage (UHC) programme. The required health care workers are in the following cadres:

1. OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST- 4 POSTS

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Assessing and formulating patient's treatment plan;
- ii. Maintaining records and data relating to patients;
- iii. Collecting data for operational research;
- iv. Sensitizing the community on occupational therapy issues; and
- v. Preparing periodic reports.

(b) Requirements for Appointment

For appointment to this grade, a candidate must have: -

- Diploma in Occupational Therapy from a recognized institution
- Registration with the relevant professional body

2. COMMUNITY HEALTH EXTENSION WORKERS- 3 POSTS

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Collecting health related data at household level for analysis;
- ii. Maintaining and updating community health unit registers and keeping records;
- iii. Identifying common ailments and minor injuries at community level;
- iv. Identifying and referring health cases to appropriate health facilities;
- v. Visiting homes to determine the health situation and dialogue with household members;
- vi. Identifying and sensitizing communities on health interventions;
- vii. Monitoring growth of children under the age of five years;
- viii. Identifying defaulters of health interventions and referring them to the appropriate health facilities;
- ix. Managing community health resource centers; and
- x. Convening and coordinating monthly community meetings and action days.

(b) Requirements for Appointment

For appointment to this grade, a candidate must have: -

- Diploma in any of the following disciplines: Community Health Nursing, Community Health, Community Oral Health, Psychology, Nutrition, Environmental Health, Counseling, Social Work, Community Development, Health Records and Information or Health Promotion and Education from a recognized institution; and
- Registration with the relevant professional body

3. PHYSIOTHERAPIST – 5 POSTS

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Screening, assessing and providing therapeutic exercises, manual therapy, electrotherapy and hydrotherapy interventions as per the patients/clients formulated treatment plan at an outpatient unit/ward/health institution;
- ii. Carrying out physical disability assessments for categorization, registration and other support;
- iii. Verifying and maintaining information and records relating to patients;
- iv. Ensuring availability of physiotherapy supplies and equipment as well as giving support and health education to patients and relatives in hospital;

- v. Carrying out home visits and following up on patient's progress;
- vi. Sensitizing the community on physiotherapy issues;
- vii. Maintaining patients/clients progress reports;
- viii. Collecting data for operational research; and
- ix. Preparing periodic reports.

(b) Requirements for Appointment

For appointment to this grade, an officer must have: -

- (i) Diploma in Physiotherapy from a recognized institution;
- (ii) Certificate of Registration from the Kenya Society of Physiotherapists (KSP).
- (iii) Current Certificate of Practice from, the Kenya Society of Physiotherapists (KSP).

4. PHARMACEUTICAL TECHNOLOGIST – 5 POSTS

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

- Compounding and dispensing medicine

(b) Requirements for Appointment

- Have passed a Diploma in Pharmaceutical Technology
- Registration with relevant professional body

5. MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGIST- 15 POSTS

a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Examining specimen, writing and recording of results,
- ii. Dispatching for clinical management,
- iii. Receiving and scrutinizing laboratory requisition forms/specimen,
- iv. Preparing clients for collection of specimen,
- v. Labelling and registering, disaggregating specimen for processing and analysis and performing routine diagnostic tests and preparing reagents,
- vi. Applying quality control on working reagents to ensure conformity with set standards

Requirements for The Appointment

- i. Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences or any equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by Kenya Medical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Board
- ii. Registration Certificate issued by the Kenya Medical technician and technologist Board (KMLTTB)
- iii. Valid practicing license from KMLTTB

6. RADIOGRAPHER- 3 POSTS

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Processing, verifying and maintaining information related to patients;
- ii. Providing care and counseling patients and their relatives before, during and after examination.
- iii. Safeguarding and providing basic maintenance and safety of medical imaging equipment in the hospital;
- iv. Establishing and maintaining Quality Assurance Programs in the department

(b) Requirements for Promotions

- Diploma in radiography /Sonography
- Registration with the relevant professional body

7. ORTHOPEDIC TRAUMA TECHNICIAN – 2 POSTS

a) Duties and Responsibilities

- i. Interpreting radiological images of orthopedic and trauma cases;
- ii. Coaching, Mentoring and providing on job training to staff working under him/her;
- iii. Carrying out minor Orthopedic Operative techniques involving insertion and removal of Steinman's pins and skull calipers;
- iv. Removing external fixators;
- v. Manipulating and reducing fractures and dislocations;
- vi. Fixing and removing casts, bandages and tractions to and from patients;
- vii. Correcting Congenital Orthopedic Talipes Equino-Varus(C.T.E.V.):
- viii. Participating in the management of minor orthopedic trauma cases in emergencies and accidents:
- ix. Sensitizing and creating awareness on orthopedic trauma conditions to communities and counseling patients/ clients with orthopedic trauma needs.

b) Requirements for Appointments

- Certificate in either Orthopedic Plaster and Traction Technology or Orthopedic Plaster Technology from a recognized institution;

- Registration with the relevant professional body
