RE: SUITABILITY INTERVIEWS FOR PLANT OPERATORS

The County Public Service Board has scheduled suitability interviews for the following employees who require to be redesignated as Plant Operators:

- a) All employees driving the county vehicles but are **not appointed** and **redesignated** as plant operators;
- b) All employees working on short term contracts, including casual workers, but are assigned plant machines.
- c) All employees not assigned plant machines, but have the prerequisite driving skills and require to be designated as plant operators

Eligible employees are required to download and fill a drivers bio data form from the county website www.nyeri.go.ke. The form can also be obtained from the relevant Departmental offices.

The duly filled bio data form should be submitted together with the relevant academic and professional qualifications to;

Plant Operator III, Job Group 'D'- 9 posts

Duties and responsibilities

- a) Operating the machines

- b) Assisting the machine attendants in identifying possible breakdowns
- c) Liaising with the officer in charge for minor repairs of the machine
- d) Making daily and weekly maintenance checks
- e) Keeping monthly records of the services of the plant
- f) Maintaining cleanliness of the machine
- g) Any other duties that may be assigned by the supervisor.

Requirements for appointment

- i) Currently working in the county public service of Nyeri, whether on permanent or short terms contracts
- ii) Valid license free from current endorsements for classes of machines that maybe required to operate
- iii) Passed Suitability Test for Plant Operators Grade III
- iv) Ability to operators more than two plants
- v) Attended a First –Aid Certificate Course lasting not less than one (1) week from St. John Ambulance or Kenya Institute of Highway and Building Technology (KIHBT) or any other recognized Institution;
- vi) Have at least five (5) years of previous satisfactory plant driving experience after obtaining the driving license
